As Director, Strategic Business Development, United Technologies Research Center (UTRC), Gary Linsey oversees the UTRC team responsible for marketing and proposing contract research to governments and companies worldwide. He also serves as UTRC's Washington office representative.

Linsey began his career at United Technologies Corporation (UTC) as an Engineer at Pratt & Whitney in 1986, holding positions of increasing responsibility within the Materials discipline before joining UTRC in 2000 as a Materials Project Leader in the Pratt & Whitney Program Office. He transitioned to Business Development in 2003 and has served as Group

Leader of Business Development since early 2010, helping to oversee a historic period of dynamic and successful growth within UTRC's external funding.

Among his several awards and honors are the Pratt & Whitney Eagle Award, 2007; UTC Senior Vice President Special Award, 2007; UTRC Director's Special Award, 2006; UTRC Outstanding Achievement Award, 2002; NASA Turning Goals to Reality Award, 2004; International Gas Turbine Institute (IGTI) Best Paper Award, 2002; and U.S. Department of Energy Research Partnership Award, 2001.
